

New SAY and PAAY Training

Learn skills to help create a safe and healthy environment for youth who have sexual behavior problems and or physically act out.

- Two new online trainings about Sexually Aggressive and Physically Assaultive/Aggressive Youth. Each training runs 1 hour 13 minutes.
- Required for all caregivers of youth identified as sexually aggressive or physically assaultive/aggressive and encouraged for all caregivers wanting to increase their skills.
