**Law & Ethics: More than Words**

**Description:**

This 4-hour interactive workshop will focus on ethical issues of interest to participants who have already had training on introductory ethics. We will explore the potential for problems created by inadequate clinical supervision, and how to reduce ensuing legal liabilities. We will identify components of an enhanced ethical agency, and ways to implement enhancements. Ethical decision making models will be applied to case studies.

**Objectives:**

The successful participant will be able to:

1. Identify some common pitfalls of ethical violations.
2. Discuss the impact of clinical supervision in a patient care facility.
3. Create a strategic plan for enhancing the ethical climate in your facility.
4. Apply ethical decision making models to case studies.
