Purpose of the proposal and its anticipated effects, including any changes in existing rules:

The First Steps Child Care Program is eliminated to meet the legislative requirements of Sections 201 and 209 of the operating budget for fiscal years 2010 and 2011.

Reasons supporting proposal:

The repeal of this rule is necessary for the department to fully meet the legislatively mandated appropriation reduction in Chapter 564, Laws of 2009 (ESHB 1244), for maternity support services. (WAC 388-533-1000 was repealed by emergency adoption effective June 1, 2009.)

Statutory authority for adoption: Chapter 564, Laws of 2009 (ESHB 1244); RCW 74.08.090 and 74.09.800
