SUMMARY

The Behavioral Health Administration (BHA) requests a annual funding adjustment in order to maintain funding levels based upon caseload and utilization changes to the Disproportionate Share Hospital Payments (DSH).

PROBLEM STATEMENT

Revenue projections at Western State Hospital (WSH) and Eastern State Hospital (ESH) are different than the earnings in the projected budget because of the current client mix.

PROPOSED SOLUTION

The sources of funding should be adjusted in order to earn all federal revenue to support current hospital operations based on the current client mix.

EXPECTED RESULTS

To maintain current patient services funded from the projected revenue sources.
