WE ARE LOOKING FOR:

Tribal partners who want to increase education and awareness regarding Alzheimer's and dementia-related diseases in their communities by hosting a Savvy Caregiver training on their Tribal lands.

WE ARE ASKING FOR:

Tribal partners to provide the space for Tribal members to participate in three days of Savvy Caregiver training. This may be a classroom, community center, or any event space free to Tribal partners.

WE WILL PROVIDE:

- Three days of FREE Savvy Caregiver Training taught by Dr. Neil Henderson, an Oklahoma Choctaw Native.
- All workbooks and study supplies required to complete the course.
- Breakfast and lunch for all three days of training.
- Continuing education credit upon the completion of Savvy Caregiver Training.
- One-on-one personal feedback and input from Dr. Henderson regarding implementation of Savvy Caregiver skills in your communities.
