RE: Approval of Washington's New Freedom Waiver Amendment (WA.0443.R03.01)

Dear Ms. Birch and Ms. Lindeblad:

The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) has approved Washington's §1915(c) Home and Community-Based Services (HCBS) New Freedom waiver amendment, CMS Transmittal Number WA.0443.R03.01. Please use this number in future correspondence relevant to the waiver. The amendment, submitted on February 28, 2020, adds the working disabled group as a Medicaid eligibility group who may receive services under this waiver.

The amendment is approved effective January 1, 2020.

The approval is subject to the agreement to serve no more individuals than those indicated in the waiver amendment. If the state wishes to serve more individuals or make any other alterations to this waiver, the state must submit an amendment for approval. The waiver continues to be cost-neutral.

It is important to note that CMS' approval of this waiver solely addresses the state's compliance with the applicable Medicaid authorities. CMS' approval does not address the state's independent and separate obligations under federal laws including, but not limited to, the Americans with Disabilities Act, Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act, or the Supreme Court's Olmstead decision.
