



## Beyond First Aid Training

### Learning Objective

In this training, you will:

1. Understand the unique health and safety needs for people with intellectual and developmental disabilities.
2. Recognize what to consider when there are changes in a person's behavior, habits, and physical condition that could be a sign of a greater medical crisis.
3. Implement new approaches to care by being proactive and knowing when to advocate for the health and safety of the people you support.
