Decision Package Process

What is a decision package?

- DPs are a key set of building blocks to construct a budget request
- The DP is the place for the agency to make a persuasive case for any proposed changes (OFM relies on this when evaluating requests)
- DPs organize and describe proposed cost changes
- If an agency submits a proposed agency request legislation with a budget impact, a corresponding
 DP must be included in the agency budget submittal


Budget Proviso

Language in the budget bills that places conditions and limitations on the use of appropriations
