

Prohibited STD/HIV Diagnosis Codes

The State of Washington does not allow collection of certain ICD diagnosis codes on the MDS (Minimum Data Set 3.0).

These codes are sensitive data for persons with STD and/or HIV. (Sexually Transmitted Diseases and/or Human Immunodeficiency Viruses). As under the previous RUG-IV model, the presence of an AIDS diagnosis continues to be identified by entering ICD-10-CM code B20 on the Claim but not in MDS.

MDS assessments using these codes will be rejected with a Fatal Error message.

To submit the assessment successfully, remove the code from Section I.
