## VISITOR PARKING PASS Washington State Agencies Lacey Center

The *Lacey Center Parking Plan* specifies where employees and/or visitors to Washington State Agencies located in the Lacey Center may park their vehicles.

Visitors to State Agencies located in the Lacey Center are required to place a **Visitor Parking Pass** on their vehicle's dashboard. Visitors are asked to park in the following areas:

(1) Visitor Designated Area OR

OK

(2) Any Open Employee Parking Space Does <u>not</u> include parking in a carpool or other marked reserved area

NOTE: Visitors with a proper ADA permit (placard or plate) may park in any ADA or general parking without a visitor permit.

Parking in the Lacey Center for State Agencies is limited. Visitors are encouraged to use alternative transportation options, such as carpooling or riding the bus.
