<p>Presentation of spread sheet with 1218 requirement, CFR, WAC, relevant research findings, pros and cons of research findings, workgroup recommendations. The presentation focused on items that work group provided several comments to in the previous meeting and SHB 1218 requirements we had not yet discussed. These comments prompted RCS staff to look at additional research to explore these topics appropriately. RCS looked at states with similar hazard profiles as Washington as well as other states.</p> <p>Topic areas discussed in this presentation include disaster plan development and maintenance, local expert participation in plan development, risk assessments, emergency provisions, providing emergency information, and staff training. For each of these topics, RCS staff walked through research from other states and shared their observations.
