**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO CHAPTER 388-76 WAC, ADULT FAMILY HOME**  
**MINIMUM LICENSING REQUIREMENTS**

The Department of Social and Health Services (department) is proposing amending sections of Chapter 388-76 WAC. This project is to update rules that were adopted by reference from Chapter 51-51 WAC, which was changed earlier in 2020.

Recently the department filed the CR-102, a more formal phase of the rule-making process, with the Office of the Code Reviser.
