ALTSA: AFH #2023-017 CR-101 FILED TO PROPOSE AMENDING SECTIONS OF CHAPTER 388-76 WAC (ADULT FAMILY HOME MINIMUM LICENSING REQUIREMENTS)

Dear AFH Provider:

In response to a petition for rule making, the department is considering amending WAC 388-76-10315, Resident Record- Required. These changes will align the rule with federal requirements for access to resident records by the Long-Term Care Ombuds Program and provide clear language for adult family homes to follow.

A CR-101 (WSR 23-09-049) was filed with the Office of the Code Reviser on April 17, 2023, to begin the rule making process.
