CR 102 FILED TO PROPOSE ADDING & AMENDING SECTIONS
TO CHAPTER 388-101

Dear Certified Community Residential Services and Supports Provider:

In June 2015, the Department began the rulemaking process to add and amend sections to Chapter 388-101 of the Washington Administrative Code (WAC) for Certified Community Residential Services and Supports (CCRSS).

Recently, the Department filed a CR-102, a more formal phase of the rule making process. The CR-102, including proposed rule language, is available on the Aging and Long Term Services Administration (ALTSA) professional page for CCRSS providers. These proposed changes are the result of the following legislation:

- House Bill 1307 passed during this legislative session and adds progressive enforcement options to the WAC chapter and allows RCS to be more flexible with remedies.
- Substitute Senate Bill 5600 passed during this legislative session and changed portions of the definition of abuse.
- Initiative 1163 passed in 2011 but had some requirements for supported living staff around training and fingerprint checks that do not go into effect until January 2016.
