## ALTSA: ICF/IID #2014-010 ICF/IID INFORMAL DISPUTE RESOLUTION TRANSITIONS TO RCS IDR UNIT

Dear ICF/IID Superintendent/Administrator:

This letter is to inform you that effective November 1, 2014, Informal Dispute Resolution (IDR) for ICFs/IID will be conducted by the Residential Care Services (RCS) IDR Unit. Historically, IDR for ICFs/IID have been conducted by the Quality Assurance Administrator responsible for the ICF/IID Program.

IDR Unit staff are specifically designated and trained to conduct IDR reviews and currently conduct all such reviews for state licensed facilities including Adult Family Homes, Assisted Living Facilities and Nursing Homes.

Please note that this is an internal business change only. The intent of this change is to establish consistent processes across all programs regulated by Residential Care Services. The RCS IDR Unit will begin hearing IDR for ICFs/IID in early December 2014.
