AMENDMENTS TO CHAPTER 388-111 WAC

Dear ICF/IID Superintendent:

In December 2014, the department began the rulemaking process to add and amend sections of Chapter 388-111 WAC in order to repeal the section references to Resident Client Protection Program (RCPP).

In May, 2015, you were informed that the Department had filed a CR-102, a more formal stage of the rule making process. Recently, the Department filed a supplemental CR-102 due to a delay in the original rule making process. The CR-102, including proposed rule language, is available on the ALTSA website: <https://www.dshs.wa.gov/altsa/residential-care-services/information-icfsiid-providersviders>, under the heading, "Rule Filings".

Highlights of the intended changes include the following:

- Repeals RCPP program section references from Chapter 388-111 WAC. The program has been moved and is now a part of the Adult Protective Services (APS) program with Home and Community Services.


