RISK ASSESSMENT DURING HOLIDAY TRAVEL

Dear Provider/Superintendent/Administrator:

As the holidays rapidly near, we recognize that holiday travels may have an impact on the transmission of COVID-19 as we visit our friends and families. With the accelerating transmission of the disease reported in this comprehensive up-to-date picture of what is happening around the state, see the WA State COVID-19 Risk Assessment and WADOH COVID-19 data dashboards, we would like to remind facilities of the importance of the risk assessment to assess COVID-19 exposure risk in long-term care facilities.

Please review the following risk assessment criteria for your facility type:

- Adult Family Homes Assisted Living Facilities & Enhanced Service Facilities:
 - o Risk Assessment Template to Assess COVID-19 Exposure Risk for Residents/Clients after Community Visits
 - o Safe Start for Long-Term Care Recommendations and Requirements
- Nursing Homes and Intermediate Care Facilities for Individuals with Intellectual Disabilities:
 - o Risk Assessment Template to Assess COVID-19 Exposure Risk for Residents/Clients after Community Visits
 - o Safe Start for Long-Term Care Recommendations and Requirements
- Certified Community Residential Services and Supports:
 - Risk Assessment Template to Assess COVID-19 Exposure Risk for Residents and Clients after Community Visits and the Letter to Families when residents/clients are preparing for community activities
 - o Safe Start for Long-Term Care Recommendations and Requirements
