Dear Provider/Administrator:

The department is considering amending sections Chapters 388-76, 388-78A, 388-97, and 388-107 WAC related to adult family homes, assisted living facilities, nursing homes, and enhanced services facilities. The intent is to provide clarity to the resident medication rules, including labeling, documentation, and storage of resident medications, specifically related to the implementation of the Death with Dignity Act.

A CR-101 (<u>WSR 23-08-038</u>) was filed with the Office of the Code Reviser on March 29, 2023, to begin the rule making process.
