This new Retention Toolkit helps supervisors and managers of direct care staff address retention issues, reduce high turnover rates, and continue providing quality care. The toolkit will be initially available to supervisors of staff who are not members of the Service Employees International Union (SEIU).

The toolkit includes online courses and other resources covering various topics related to leadership, management, and retention. Modules that will launch are Onboarding, Communication, Recognition, and Wellness. Additional modules will be added in the future.
