Dear Administrator or Provider:

On November 05, 2024, the Department of Social and Health Services (department) withdrew the CR-101 filed under WSR 24-18-013. On November 5, 2024, the department refiled a CR-101 on this project under <u>WSR 24-22-123</u>. The new filing clarifies the scope of the rulemaking, which will address the need for a legally enforceable agreement between the operators of Adult Family Homes (AFH), Assisted Living Facilities, (ALF), and Enhanced Services Facilities (ESF), and residents in those settings whose care is paid through Medicaid. This rulemaking is needed to comply with federal regulations for Home and Community Based Settings.
