NH #2025-035 EXPIRED - QSO 19-07-NH: ENHANCED OVERSIGHT AND ENFORCEMENT OF NON-IMPROVING LATE ADOPTERS

Dear Nursing Facility/Home Administrator:

This DPL supersedes Dear Provider Letter (DPL) NH #019-008.

On March 3, 2019, CMS published <u>QSO 19-07-NH</u> to provide information regarding enhanced oversight and enforcement actions for facilities identified as "late adopters" due to their lack of improvement in rates of utilization of antipsychotic medication for long-stay NH residents.

On July 30, 2025, QSO 19-07-NH expired.

**Effective immediately**, refer to <u>QSO 25-14-NH</u> & <u>State Operations Manual</u>, <u>Appendix PP</u> for revised guidance regarding "unnecessary psychotropics" being integrated into the chemical restraints regulation at F605.
