Through an approved CMP grant, the Alzheimer's Association has launched its innovative *Care Community Coaching Program* in Washington State. Teams of staff from participating nursing homes are working (virtually) with an Association coach to adopt and implement the ten areas of the Dementia Care Practice Recommendations (DCPR). These topic areas include **person-centered care, dementia-related behaviors, activities of daily living, supportive and therapeutic environments and workforce.**

Over the next six-eight months, these teams, whose members represent different functions/departments, will work with an Alzheimer's Association Practice Coach. Together, they will assess their communities' strengths and opportunities, and prioritize strategies to implement best-practices within the DCPR topic areas.
