



Safe Home Training Program
*Best Practices for Serving LGBTQ+ and Racial and Ethnic Populations
in Long-Term Care Communities*

The UW Goldsen Institute’s AgePRIDE Center is currently recruiting 36 WA State nursing homes to bring the “Safe Home” training to your community! Safe Home is a free, CMP grant funded training for direct care staff to learn and practice skills to build more inclusive care for LGBTQ+ and racial and ethnic minorities in nursing homes in WA state.

The UW AgePRIDE Center has developed the Safe Home training program to address the unique barriers vulnerable older adults face in accessing the care they need in nursing homes in WA state. This program is the first evidence-based training program to address the distinct and intersecting needs of LGBTQ+ and racial and ethnic minorities in long-term care communities in the State of Washington. These will be skill-based trainings with a focus on ensuring that direct care staff develop specific and transferable skills resulting in more inclusive care for health disparate, underserved populations.
