

Definition of Options Counseling

ADRC Options Counseling is an interactive process where individuals receive guidance in their deliberations to make informed choices about long-term supports. The process is directed by the individual and may include others that the person chooses or those that are legally authorized to represent the individual. **ADRC Options** Counseling Program **Functions**

Washington State Grant

 Achieve statewide implementation of a Options Counseling Training and Certification program to facilitate statewide ADRC expansion.

- Individuals who contact the ADRC are able to make informed decisions about their LTSS options.
- Individuals and family caregivers are able to effectively navigate the LTSS system and access the options they have identified as meeting their needs.
- Individuals who contact ADRCs have increased community tenure in their homes and communities.
- Public resources are used effectively to help individuals learn about and access LTSS
- Trends in costs of LTSS and health care are slower compared to current projected growth.

• Develop and implement a standards-based curriculum and training process to increase capacity of ADRCs and partners to deliver a quality Options Counseling program statewide.

- Hire a curriculum developer/trainer
- Procure statewide and community-based Options
 Counseling Organizations in addition to AAAs' ADRCs
- Develop and implement a Train-the-Trainer program to increase dissemination of Options Counseling.

• Develop and implement a standards-based Options Counseling Certification program.

- Participate in finalizing the national Options Counseling Certification program.
- Promote national Options Counseling Certification to ADRCs and their partners and encourage their participation in staff becoming certified.
- Develop Certification preparatory training for staff of ADRCs and their partners.

•Expand the Washington State Veterans Directed Home Services Program.

- Work with Puget Sound and Spokane VAs for VDHS-ADRC opportunities.
- Work with the Veterans' Administration to examine opportunities for simplification of billing processes in order to support cost efficiency.

- •Continue to support the delivery of the Care Transition Program developed by Dr. Eric Coleman throughout the state.
- Develop and apply Continuous Quality Improvement principles and Evaluation Plan.
