

Consumer Directed Employer (CDE) Project Talking Points #20 – CDWA, the CDE Vendor

Who is the CDE vendor?

In January 2020, DSHS signed a contract with Consumer Direct Washington (CDWA) to serve as the CDE for Washington state. DSHS is currently working with CDWA to finalize the statewide implementation schedule. There will be a pilot before CDWA begins a multi-phase rollout across the state. The Department remains committed to initiating the transition to the CDE by the legislatively required date of June 30, 2021.
