<p>Old Business</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Investment and Implementation Plan Update 	<p>Chris Hanak, Senior Investment Officer at the Washington State Investment Board (WSIB) provided an update on the investment and implementation plan for the new WA Cares Fund (LTSS Trust) program.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • WSIB has an onboarding process for new stakeholders and they will initiate the required steps in the second half of this year to ensure they are ready to receive and invest funds once they become available. This includes: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Establishment of accounts; ○ Defining working relationships for asset transfers and instructions; and ○ Creation of a performance reporting process and cadence. • WSIB determines how assets are invested. • The initial strategic asset allocation process assumed passage of the constitutional amendment, Engrossed Senate Joint Resolution (ESJR) 8212 in the November 2020 election. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ The constitutional amendment would have allowed the WA Cares Fund (LTSS Trust) be invested in a mix of internally managed fixed income and externally managed equity assets. • Since ESJR 8212 did not pass, the investment options for WA Cares Fund are limited. • Typically funds with this constitutional limitation are smaller in scope and more temporary in nature. • WA Cares Fund has a longer-term investment need and may require a distinct investment solution. • WSIB will do research and explore options that enable more effective long-term investment of the assets within the constitutional limitations and report back their findings. • There is a clear list of acceptable investments that are permitted under the state constitution.
<p>Old Business</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Investment Strategy Subcommittee Charter 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Ben provided an overview of the updates to the Investment Strategy Subcommittee charter. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Changed LTSS Trust program to WA Cares Fund ○ Added the LTSS Trust Foundational Principles approved by the Commission. ○ Replaced the term asset allocation study with investment and implementation plan because WSIB will not be doing an asset allocation study • Senator King made a motion to accept the proposed charter as revised and updated. A voice vote was taken and the motion passed.
