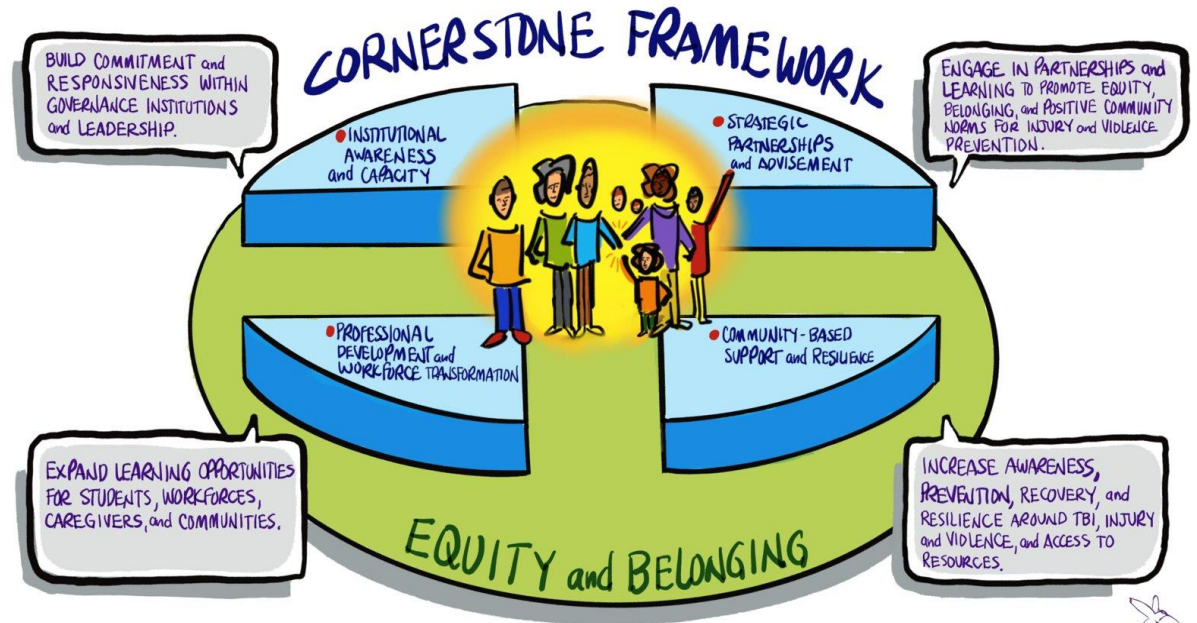
## **What we value:**

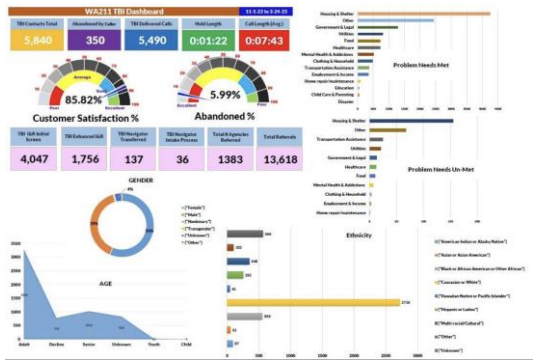
# 1. Person-Centered Care

- Past pathways – Caregivers, Navigating Healthcare, etc.
- Cornerstone framework
- Update and align for Information & Referral



# 2. Data-Driven Decisions

- Information & Referral (WA 211 real-time data)
- Demographics, requests, needs, gaps, etc.
- Year-long TBI needs survey (CBIRT)

**Thinking about the complexities of equity + TBI, consider these three key strategic outcomes:**

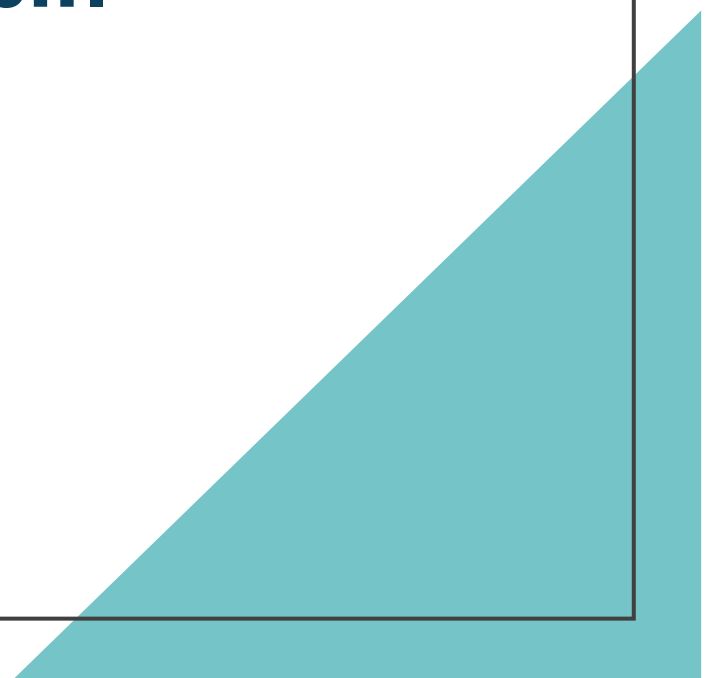
- **Prevent** TBI in marginalized populations through public awareness and outreach.
