

## **Advanced Home Care Aide Specialist Pilot Eligibility**

<p><b>Eligibility Requirements</b></p>	<p>To initially enroll in the Advanced Home Care Aide Specialist pilot:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• People receiving services must: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Complete and sign a Participation Agreement form as well as a Release of Information form.</li> <li>○ Be receiving personal in-home care services from DSHS (either through the Home and Community Services division of the Aging and Long-Term Support Administration, or from the Developmental Disabilities Administration).</li> <li>○ Be receiving Medicaid Health Home Services AND/OR have a CARE Behavior Score of 12 or above prior to pilot enrollment.</li> <li>○ Currently have (or agree to have within 60 days of pilot enrollment) a Health Action Plan from Health Home Services AND/OR a Behavior Support Plan.</li> <li>○ Be receiving personal care from a pilot-eligible individual provider (see criteria below).</li> </ul> </li> <li>• Individual providers must: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Complete and sign a Participation Agreement form.</li> <li>○ Be a certified Home Care Aide (HCA) (or exempt as described by Washington Administrative Code 246-980-070).</li> </ul> </li> <li>• Discontinuation, Loss of Eligibility, and Provider Compensation: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ A service recipient may choose to drop out of the pilot at any time.</li> <li>○ Any service recipient who fails to provide a Health Action Plan AND/OR a Behavior Support Plan within 60 days of pilot enrollment, or who fails to maintain an active plan will be dis-enrolled from the pilot.</li> <li>○ Any service recipient residing in a hospital or residential facility for more than 30 days during the pilot period will be dis-enrolled from the pilot.</li> <li>○ Individual providers will only receive the payment differential associated with this pilot once they have completed the training requirements and are working as a certified Advanced Home Care Aide Specialist. They will only receive the payment differential while working with individuals that are currently enrolled in the pilot.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
