Please find attached the T.R. Quality Management Plan. This plan will provide the foundation for measuring the implementation and success of the Commitments set forth in the *T.R. v. Quigley and Teeter* Settlement Agreement dated December 19, 2013, and informed by the terms of the WISE Implementation Plan dated August 1, 2014. This is intended to be a working document until its full implementation on or before December 19, 2016.

This plan represents a year-long collaborative process including family members, plaintiff attorneys, Washington State Attorney General, staff from the Division of Behavioral Health and Recovery, representatives from Regional Service Networks and community mental health agencies, cross-system partners, and consultants from the University of Washington and Chapin Hall. It took long conversations and many drafts to define and outline the criteria, data sources, measures, and feedback mechanisms that will support successful WISE implementation and lead to improved outcomes for youth and families. The Quality Management Plan will continue to adapt and change to support continuous quality improvement, an enduring value for each of us.
