Subject: Draft 1915(b) Behavioral Health Waiver Amendment

The Department of Social and Health Services (DSHS), Behavioral Health Administration (BHA) intends to submit an amendment to the current 1915(b) behavioral health waiver in order to facilitate movement of the North Central Regional Service Area (NCRSA) into a fully integrated model. The NCRSA includes Chelan, Douglas, and Grant counties.

The North Central Behavioral Health Organization (BHO) is currently responsible for Medicaid managed care behavioral health services in the NCRSA. While all regions of the state must adopt the fully integrated model by 2020, NCRSA has chosen to implement full integration earlier, on January 1, 2018. In a fully integrated region, there are no BHOs, and Managed Care Organizations (MCOs) manage both medical and behavioral health services for those individuals in the managed care system.

Upon CMS approval, the waiver amendment will take effect on January 1, 2018.
