<b>Reporting Measures of Statewide Performance</b> Data Displays indicator 2.1 - Barb Lucenko  indicator 5.4 – Felix Rodriguez	Barb shared the data for indicators 2.1a, 2.1b and 2.2. A question was raised about whether CA out of home placement includes BRS in addition to foster care. BRS is a service and thus can occur in multiple settings.  Felix shared many possible ways of displaying the data for indicator 5.4 including by age, gender, race/ethnicity of child/youth. There was little variation in these displays; other potential sources of variation were discussed, e.g., geographic, by agency characteristics, urban/rural	Barb will clarify what is included in CA out of home placement and report back in September.  Felix will pursue further analyses of these data and bring findings to September meeting. The percent of youth/children agreeing/strongly disagreeing with the 3 questions related to cultural competence will be displayed on the Measures of Statewide Performance. Felix will work with Barb Felver and Barb Lucenko to accomplish that.
