

DIRECTIONS TO AD SA HQ

NORTHBOUND I-5

Take exit 108 and stay in the left lane (College St. Exit). This merges into 3rd Ave. Turn right at the light onto College St. Continue 0.8 miles to Pacific Ave. and turn right. At the traffic circle, turn right onto Golf Club Road. Turn right on 10th Ave. SE and take the first left into the parking lot. Blake Office Park West is the first building on your right, and Blake Office Park East is the second building on your right.

SOUTHBOUND I-5

Take exit 109 (Martin Way) Turn right at the end of the off-ramp onto Martin Way. Turn left at the first light onto College St. Continue 0.8 miles to Pacific Ave. and turn right. At the traffic circle, turn right onto Golf Club Road. Turn right on 10th Ave. SE and take the first left into the parking lot. Blake Office Park West is the first building on your right, and Blake Office Park East is the second building on your right.

PARKING PASS

The Lacey Center State Offices have a **Parking Management Plan** that determines where employees and visitors may park their vehicles.

Visitors are required to place a Visitor Parking Pass on their vehicle's dashboard. Visitors are asked to park in the following areas:

- (1) Visitor Designated Area
OR
- (2) Any Open Employee Parking Space
Does not include parking in a carpool or reserved area

NOTE: Visitors with proper ADA permit (placard or plate) may park in any ADA or general parking without a visitor permit.

Parking in the Lacey Center State Offices is limited. Visitors are encouraged to use alternative transportation options, such as carpooling or riding the bus.
