

Incredible Years (IY) Fee Table

<p>Group IY</p>	<p>The per session rate includes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Engaging families to attend the class; • Therapist time to prepare for and deliver the IY service; • Weekly check in's with participants; • Associated reporting/notification and documentation requirements outlined in the statement of work; • Therapist participation in model fidelity requirements of IY; • Weekly meals for the families; • Materials for the families; • Child supervision provided; and • Transportation of group participant from their home, to the weekly group sessions and back home. Transportation shall be provided up to the cost of \$65 for all group participants at current Office of Financial Management rates. <p>Must have a minimum of CA referred participants to begin an IY Group as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Baby - 5 • Toddler - 8 • Preschool - 10 <p>All IY Groups must maintain a minimum of 4 actively attending group members. If a group's actively attending membership falls below 4, the Contractor shall notify referring social workers and transition the families to Weekly In-Home IY sessions. When transitioning families to Weekly In-Home Sessions, the group session limits transfers to In-Home (e.g. a family participating in Baby Group, transitions to In-Home after 5 group sessions, the family is eligible for 7 more sessions).</p> <p>DSHS will reimburse for a maximum of IY group sessions per family per authorized referral as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Baby 10 sessions • Toddler 14 sessions • Preschool 18 sessions 	<p>\$975 per weekly group</p>
	<p>Participant fee per session (based on attendance)</p>	<p>\$41 per DSHS client per week</p>

	<p>Course completion fee paid for each participant who successfully completes at least 80% of the IY education program (a.k.a. a program graduate).</p> <p>Paid only once per service intervention upon completion.</p>	\$40 per DSHS client
Weekly In Home IY Session	<p>The per session rate includes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Therapist time to prepare for and deliver the IY service, • Associated reporting/notification and documentation requirements outlined in the statement of work, • Therapist participation in model fidelity requirements of NCAST, • Clinical supervision; and • Materials for the family. <p>Sessions should be fifty (50) to ninety (90) minutes.</p> <p>DSHS will reimburse for a maximum of IY In-Home sessions per family per authorized referral as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Preschool- 21 sessions • Toddler- 17 sessions • Baby- 11 sessions 	\$143 per session
Case Related Activities	<p>Case related activities may only be billed in conjunction with In-Home and may include but are not limited to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Collateral contacts (in-person or electronic), • Attendance at CA authorized meetings or staffing, • Establishing or enhancing a family's connections to the community, • In person client activities to support case plan or safety plan (e.g. community connections). <p>Case related activities shall not exceed 12 hours per family per referral.</p> <p>Activities not considered Case Related include but are not limited to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All work delivering IY services; • Clinical supervision or participation in fidelity monitoring; • Case updates with CA social worker (except as part of a formal staffing) • Standard documentation (e.g. case updates, Notifications or Intervention Plans) and writing of monthly report, intervention completion report, and compilation report. 	\$65.00 per hour for actual time
Case Related Travel	<p>DSHS shall pay the Contractor for actual case related travel. Case related travel shall only include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Travel to and from the family's home to provide services; • The Contractor shall adhere to the following travel time stipulations: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Arrange visits in the family home to limit travel time; • Allowable travel time is portal to portal. CA will use Google Maps to evaluate reasonableness of claimed time; 	\$ 32.50 per hour.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Travel time shall be calculated as the shortest distance from the counselor’s residence, counselor’s office, previous client appointment, whichever is the shortest distance; • No reimbursement for travel shall be paid for travel between counselor’s residence and office; and • Travel time shall be reasonable. <p>Current state rate on date service delivered. Current rates for travel can be accessed at: http://ofm.wa.gov/policy/10.90a.pdf</p> <p>Any travel beyond 50 miles to the appointment or returning (i.e. one-way) must be authorized by the Regional Program Manager</p>	
Service Duration	<p>IY shall be delivered within the following timelines:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. IY Group, starting from the first class. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a. Baby 10 sessions b. Toddler 14 sessions c. Preschool 18 sessions 2. IY In-Home, starting from the initial in-person meeting. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a. Preschool- 21 sessions b. Toddler- 17 sessions c. Baby- 11 sessions d. Shorter timeframes on a case by case bases may be identified by the Social Service Specialist. The Contractor shall follow any shorter timeframes, as model fidelity allows, identified by the Social Service Specialists.
