

**Promoting First Relationship (PFR) Fee Table  
Effective 11-1-2016**

<p><b>Weekly Session</b></p>	<p>The per session rate includes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Therapist time to prepare for and deliver the PFR service,</li> <li>• Associated reporting/notification and documentation requirements outlined in the statement of work,</li> <li>• Therapist participation in model fidelity requirements of NCAST,</li> <li>• Clinical supervision; and</li> <li>• Materials for the family.</li> </ul> <p>Sessions should be fifty (50) to ninety (90) minutes.</p> <p>DSHS will reimburse for a <b>maximum of sixteen (16)</b> PFR sessions per family per authorized referral.</p>	<p>\$138 per session</p>
<p><b>Case Related Activities</b></p>	<p>Case related activities may include but are not limited to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Collateral contacts (in-person or electronic),</li> <li>• Attendance at CA authorized meetings or staffing,</li> <li>• Establishing or enhancing a family's connections to the community,</li> <li>• In person client activities to support case plan or safety plan (e.g. community connections).</li> </ul> <p>Case related activities shall not exceed 12 hours per family per referral.</p> <p>Activities <b>not</b> considered Case Related include but are not limited to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• All work delivering PFR services;</li> <li>• Clinical supervision or participation in fidelity monitoring;</li> <li>• Case updates with CA social worker (except as part of a formal staffing)</li> <li>• Standard documentation (e.g. case updates, Notifications or Intervention Plans) and writing of monthly report, intervention completion report, and compilation report.</li> <li>• </li> </ul>	<p>\$65.00 per hour</p>
<p><b>Case Related Travel</b></p>	<p>DSHS shall pay the Contractor for actual case related travel. Case related travel shall only include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Travel to and from the family's home to provide services;</li> <li>• The Contractor shall adhere to the following travel time stipulations: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Arrange visits in the family home to limit travel time;</li> <li>• Allowable travel time is portal to portal. CA will use Google Maps to evaluate reasonableness of claimed time;</li> <li>• Travel time shall be calculated as the shortest distance from the counselor's residence, counselor's office, previous client appointment, whichever is the shortest distance;</li> <li>• No reimbursement for travel shall be paid for travel between counselor's residence and office; and</li> <li>• Travel time shall be reasonable.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>	<p>\$32.50 per hour</p>

<b>Service Duration</b>	<p>1. PFR shall be delivered within the following timelines:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. Placement prevention and Reunification referrals shall be completed within 18 weeks of the initial in person meeting.</li> <li>b. Shorter timeframes on a case by case bases may be identified by the Social Service Specialist. The Contractor shall follow any shorter timeframes, as model fidelity allows, identified by the Social Service Specialists.</li> </ul>
