	Completed Intervention –	<p>A Complete Intervention includes the completion of each of the following service steps:</p> <p><u>Step 1</u> - Engagement activities</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Review referral information;</li> <li>2. Contact family; and</li> <li>3. Meet with family face to face.</li> </ol> <p><u>Step 2</u> - Crisis Stabilization</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Identify family goals;</li> <li>2. Collaborate with referring Social Worker on initial assessment and related action steps;</li> <li>3. Implement action steps with the family to address their needs; and</li> <li>4. Conduct a termination session that includes:                             <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. A transition plan for the family, which shall include the therapist's recommendations to the family for services that shall assist the child and family to maintain changes and improve family functioning;</li> <li>b. Review community connections with the family; and</li> <li>c. Collect the family's perspective of change.</li> </ol> </li> </ol> <p><u>Step 3</u> - Service Summary &amp; Family Assessment</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. 	Incomplete Intervention	<p>May not be used with any other service.</p> <p>An Incomplete Intervention occurs if services discontinue after the therapist has completed:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Step 1- Engagement activities</li> <li>▪ Step 2 -Crisis Stabilization - at least (2) sessions or (2) hours of face to face counseling of (Crisis Stabilization), AND the Contractor and the family are unable to achieve the family goals</li> <li>▪ OR the family discontinues services during Step 2 prior to the completion of the termination session</li> </ul>	\$512.93

		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Step 3 -Service Summary &amp; Family Assessment</li> </ul> <p>The provider must complete Step 3 to bill for Steps 1 and 3</p>	
	Attempted Intervention	<p>Payment for service referrals for which family was unavailable for service, for example, if the family refused services or the provider was unable to contact the family. May not be billed with any other services.</p>	\$48.85
<b>Maximum Payment</b>	The maximum payment per authorized referral includes a cumulative total of all steps.		\$1,465,50
<b>Service Duration</b>	Provide up to a maximum of 12 hours face-to-face crisis counseling for referred family during a 45-day period. The 45-day period begins the day the Contractor receives the referral		
<b>Travel Expenses</b>	<p>CA shall consider exceptional travel costs, <u>only</u> when documented travel expenses exceeds \$200 on average for all families serviced.</p> <p>If exceptional travel costs are approved by the CA regional program lead, Contractor may bill mileage costs according to the current state rate on date service delivered.
