**Annual Progress and Services Report FY 2005
Juvenile Justice Transfers**

The Children's Administration gathered data from the Case and Management Information system (CAMIS) on children who experienced a Juvenile Rehabilitation placement as the last event of Federal FY 2004, and whose cases were closed as "transfer of custody". While transfer of custody is rare, CAMIS lists Juvenile Rehabilitation events for 135 children who were in out-of-home care during Federal FY 2004.

There was only one child, a Native American male.
