- Recognize the tendency for you to get into power struggles.

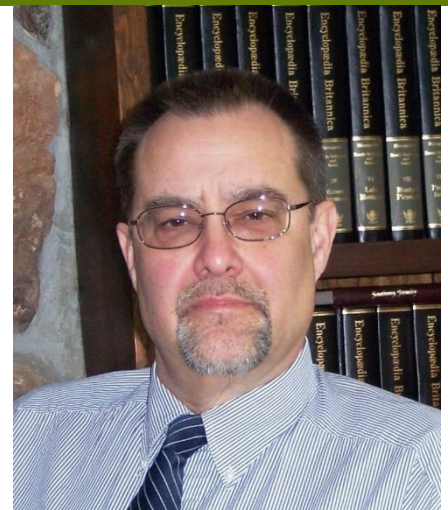
