Becoming an Elder Supporting People with Developmental Disabilities as they Age

This workshop is based on current information gathered and reviewed about aging in the general population and aging in people with intellectual and developmental disabilities. This workshop focuses on issues related to aging with DD, aging and mental health, aging and women's issues; end-of-life care; how to use person-centered practices to shift support strategies when providing care, while ensuring a rich quality of life. Through interactive exercises, participants use tools that help them devise and implement practical strategies to customize the support provided to people as they age with a focus on quality of life and meaningful relationships.

Target audience: anyone providing support and/or advocating for an individual with intellectual or developmental disabilities who is aging (45 years or older) in a residential setting.
