Increasing Employee Retention


DDA Contract providers have identified employee retention as a high-priority issue in their ability to provide quality services and supports. Employee retention is complex, beginning with initial employment marketing methods and ending on employees last day of work. This training will provide an in-depth review of current retention best practices using the Checklist For Success Assessment Tool.
