Managing Challenging Behaviors

In this program we will define behavior as it pertains to the population, understand what the cause & effect of behaviors mean to the caregiver and explore individual learning styles. We will explore a few commonly used problem solving methods, attempt to understand assessment protocols for changes in behavior and consider prevention approaches. We will discuss self care of the caregiver, consistency, empowerment and choice as we look at behaviors like handling a client's anger, resistance, anxiety, as well as disrespectful and sexual behaviors. And finally time permitting, we will also learn a couple of skills for communicating in challenging situations. This session is interactive so bring your challenges and let's work on some solution seeking.
