for 2015-2016 high school transition graduates!

The Developmental Disabilities Administration has employment funding and you may qualify if you:

- Want to work
- Were born between September 1, 1993 and August 31, 1995
- Are not on a Home and Community Based Services Waiver – but would like to be
- Are functionally and financially eligible for Community First Choice personal care services



If you meet these criteria and request the employment service, you will be placed on the Home and Community Based Services Basic Plus waiver. You can also begin to receive long-term employment services.

Employment Services

Individual Supported Employment: discovery by identifying interests, strengths, and needs, assessment, job placement, and coaching.

Group Supported Employment: supervised employment for groups of no more than eight workers with disabilities in the same settings.
