Supporting individuals with Neurodevelopmental Disorders and/or mental health issues can require unique and individualized supports. This course will focus on how functional assessments and positive behavior support plans can help individuals live their best lives. Each region's clinical team participated in the development of this training. Training topics include:

- Policies guiding FA/PBSPs
 - Person-centered planning
 - History and assessment
 - Turning the FA into a plan
 - Replacement behaviors
 - Data collection and analysis
- And much more!

Participants will be introduced to DDA's preferred structure of a functional assessment and positive behavior support plan and will leave with a foundation in how to write person-centered able-to-be implemented plans and how to determine their effectiveness.
