

HOW DOES MRSA LOOK?



MRSA may look like a “spider bite”

Watch for skin infections that look like a “pimple or boil”

-- red, warm, swollen, painful,
may have pus/drainage



COMMON APPEARANCE:



MRSA MAY BE VISIBLE OR IT MAY NOT--

➤ “Active infection”

Has Symptoms -

Boil/sore/open lesion or cut,
or systemic infection



➤ “Inactive” / “Carrier” / “Colonized”

Has No Symptoms -

But MRSA remains on skin or in
nose/respiratory tract /other
body system
