

Contract Code: 1789XP-12 DDD Nursing Services

Statement of Work.

The Contractor shall provide the services and staff, and otherwise do all things necessary for or incidental to the performance of work, as set forth below:

- a. Perform nursing service activities within the scope of practice of the Contractor's license and in compliance with the rules in WAC 246-840 for registered nursing, and licensed practical nursing.
- b. Perform skilled nursing services as required by the relevant terms of the Client's Service Plan, including any supplements or amendments to the Client's Service Plan, which will be provided to the Contractor by DSHS. Any and all relevant terms provided to Contractor shall be incorporated by reference into this Agreement.
- c. Provide the Client Skilled Nursing Services as authorized in the Client's Service Plan and in a manner consistent with protecting and promoting the Client's health and welfare and appropriate to the Client's physical and psychological needs.
- d. The Contractor shall fulfill one or more of the following responsibilities, as authorized by DSHS:
 - (1) Administer drugs, injections, inoculations, treatments and tests;
 - (2) Provide observation, assessment, nursing diagnosis, health care and teaching to clients and their primary care givers;
 - (3) Initiate emergency medical treatment; and/or
 - (4) Provide training, consultation and/or monitoring of health care to clients and their primary care givers.
- e. The Contractor shall also:
 - (1) Attend the Client's SP meeting when requested by DDD;
 - (2) Maintain an ongoing, updated health care plan for each client;
 - (3) Maintain a record of the specific dates and times of all services provided; and/or
 - (4) Upon request submit a report of any training or consultation to DSHS within ten (10) working days.
