



Our Housing Resource team can help in the following ways:Provide assistance navigating housing services and systems in King County.Provide assistance to navigate and apply for relevant social service resources such as DDA, SSI, Section 8, DVR, etc.Support in understanding tenant rights, access reasonable accommodations, and effectively communicate with landlords.Provide knowledge of low-income and subsidized housing resources in King County.Initial screening and referral to King County's Best Starts for Kids Youth & Family Homelessness Prevention Program for eligible families (see more information below).

Our staff come from the same culture and speak the same language as the families they serve, and so are able to communicate with the family in their own language, and in a way that will make sense within their cultural context. Additionally, these staff are knowledgeable of disabilities services, Special Education, and other mainstream social services, and to bridge the gap between the families we serve and the services they need. Currently, our bilingual/bicultural Family Support Staff provide services in English, Spanish, Somali, Korean, Mandarin Chinese, Cantonese, Arabic, Vietnamese, and Khmer.

Emergency Food Vouchers to Support Those in Need During COVID-19: The City of Seattle is taking steps to help residents who may be experiencing financial hardship due to the Coronavirus outbreak. The City is contributing \$5 million to provide emergency food vouchers to approximately 6,250 families in need.

Seattle Public Schools has 26 schools that are serving as a hub for student meal support during the closure.
