- > Current self-support reserve (SSR) is calculated at 125% of the federal poverty line (FPL) for one person.
- > SSR is the basic subsistence limitation chart for determining the amount necessary to provide for basic needs. The amounts are adjusted annually.
- ➤ Basic support obligation (BSO) is the monthly child support obligation determined from the economic table based on the parties' combined monthly net income and the number of children for who support is owed.
