Percentage threshold

- Group agreed to 35% of residential time as the threshold that must be met to be considered for a deviation.

Draft language

- Discussed the need to consider both the judicial and the administrative forum when drafting language, including those parents without a court ordered parenting plan.
- Defined the 35% as being calculated using the number of hours a child spends with each parent to remain consistent with the relocation act and recent case law.
- Discussed changes to the draft language:
 - Term “scheduled” in significantly shared definition
 - For 26.19.075, work on wording of “insufficient funds in either household” language. The way it currently reads a deviation in the child support amount wouldn’t be allowed if the non-custodial parent had insufficient resources in their household.
 - Defining “insufficient resources”- based on input from the full workgroup, the subcommittee was trying to define this term. Group agreed to not define this term as it creates more questions and issues, including how to define family size and account for blended families.
- Last workgroup had language on if a person wasn’t following their parenting plan that this subcommittee could use.
