- Friday meetings and the difficulty for CP and NCP
- Pay parking
- Not on mail list that participants get
- Not getting timely notification of web page postings
- Web page postings not annotated with NEW in red
- No ability to identify the low-income representatives, as per law there must be
- No appointment of replacement CP—until now
- No transparency about paying Betson, and where we are on that
- No mention of peer review of Betson's stuff—but that may happen today.
- Delay in putting audio-video meetings on web, unwillingness to do so with BS excuses, unwillingness to furnish to us so we can host, not timely
- Conflict of interest in CSWG CP participants
- Offer to post e-mails, but subvert the public records laws.
- Disclaimer on CSWG public input alias
- Director's attempts to avoid creating public records via word doc to participants encouraging phone calls not e-mails
- Total lack of responsiveness of Policy staff to simple, legitimate questions (whose idea to put on disclaimer, who authorized it, do you have the DVD, when will the DVD of Betson be available, since it is two weeks until next meeting)
- Lack of responsibility or direction to point out errors in research presented to group when noticed
- Slowness in responding to PDR on various e-mails, that can be 90% automated, and turned around daily.
