

5. While BFET may allow a client to complete their Associates (AA) degree, it does not include Transfer degrees. If a student is looking to transfer to a 4-year program or University, they should not be referred to BFET.
6. BFET students should utilize other forms of funding for tuition whenever possible. Typically all students who attempt to enroll into BFET will be asked by the college to apply for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) as part of the enrollment process for BFET.
