## Clarifying Information – <u>WAC 388-437-0002 & WAC 388-437-0005</u>

**NOTE:** Emergency Food Supplements were issued in the months of March 2020 to February April 2021. Ongoing supplements are subject to federal approval.

## **Supplemental Issuance**

- Households on food assistance are eligible for a supplemental benefit issuance to increase their benefits to the maximum allotment for their household size starting with the month of March 2020 and will continue on a month to month basis.
  - Supplements may continue if the Food and Nutrition Service (FNS) approves and the federal public health proclamation and state disaster declaration continues.
- Beginning April 2021, all hHouseholds already receiving the maximum allotment will not receive <u>athis minimum \$95</u> emergency supplement.

**Example:** Tuyen was approved in April 2021 for the maximum food allotment of \$234. They will receive an emergency supplement of \$95, for a total of \$329 on their EBT card.

-Example: Leo was approved in April 2021 for a food allotment of \$196. They are normally eligible for an emergency supplement of \$38. Since this is less than \$95, they will receive an emergency supplement of \$95, for a total of \$291 on their EBT card.

- Households that qualify for a supplement include:
  - Households on TFA, WASHCAP, SNAP and FAP.
  - Approved applications regardless of their application date (i.e. prorated benefits).
  - Households approved for assistance but receiving a \$0 allotment.
- Staff will continue to determine the correct regular eligibility amount for the household..

- Historic overpayments/underpayments will need to be reviewed to see if the household received the maximum allotment for the month.
- <u>From March 2020 through March 2021, hHouseholds</u> cannot receive more benefits than the maximum allotment for their household size.
- Starting in April 2021, households will receive the maximum allotment for their household size, or \$95 minimum emergency supplementif they're already eligible for the maximum allotment, or if eligible for an allotment that is within \$95 of the maximum allotment for their household size will receive a supplement of \$95..
- These supplements are not subject to overpayment, unless the household is found ineligible for Basic Food.

**Example:** Tomas applied for benefits on November <u>April</u> 16, 2021th and completed an interview the same day. The worker processes and approves the case with prorated benefits in <u>November April</u> 2021 of \$97 and full allotment of \$2<u>3</u>04 in <u>May 2021December</u>. Tomas receives combined issuance of \$3<u>3</u>01 on his EBT card the next day. After the system delivers the mass issuance, an additional \$1<u>3</u>07 emergency supplement will appear on Tomas's EBT to ensure he receives the maximum food amount of \$2<u>3</u>04 for <u>April 2021November.</u>, Tomas may beis eligible for a \$95 minimumbut the system will not issue an emergency supplement for December May 2021 if FNS approves emergency supplements. as he is receiving the maximum allotment, but the system will not issue May's emergency supplement until May.as Tomas already qualifies for the maximum benefit of \$204.

• If the only reason the household is receivingHouseholds that receive less than the maximum is due to a recoupment, then the household are is not eligible for the emergency supplementstill eligible to receive a minimum \$95 emergency supplement based on their full benefit amount.

**Example:** Heather was approved in January <u>April 2021</u> for the maximum food allotment of \$204234, but due to an overpayment, \$10-23 is recouped each month<u>in regular food allotment</u>. Heather receives \$194-211 per month. She will not be eligible for a <u>minimum \$95 n</u> emergency supplement based on her original amount of \$234. as she is eligible for the maximum allotment.

## **Automatic Issuance:**

An automatic mass supplement was issued for March and/or April 2020 benefits to all households on the evening of April 3, 2020.

- Review the Aces.Online Benefit Issuance history to see when the emergency supplements were issued. Emergency supplements are coded as *FS/EBT-Supplemental Issuance 863*.
- Notices were suppressed and not required for Emergency Supplements.

After April 16, 2020, the ACES system automatically determined the emergency supplement amount owed to the recipient after approving an application or reinstatement in overnight batch.

- Staff only need to complete a manual BEG when adding a person. See Worker Responsibilities.
  - Emergency supplements will show in Aces.Online as *FS/EBT-Supplemental Issuance – 863* after overnight batch.

- Mass supplements will be performed at the beginning of the each month as we receive FNS approval.
  - We will confirm that the federal and state public health emergencies are intact one day of the month.
  - The mass supplement dates may vary depending on the availability of our system and FNS approval.

**Example:** Jon and his partner were certified from January  $202\underline{10}$  to December  $202\underline{10}$  to receive \$200 per month in food assistance due to household income. Their issuance date is the 11th of each month. As the maximum allotment for a two-person household is  $\underline{430374}$  per month, Jon and his partner will receive  $\underline{230174}$  emergency supplement each month FNS approves of the emergency supplements.

**Example:** Pheobe applies for food assistance on <u>AprilOctober</u> 5, 202<u>10</u> after she lost her job. The worker interviews her on <u>April 17October</u> 17, 202<u>10</u>, determines her eligible and approves the prorated benefit amount of \$168 from the date of application. The system will automatically issue emergency supplements in overnight batch for <u>a minimum</u> \$<u>95 emergency supplement</u>. <u>36 asto give her sShe would normally receive a is within \$66 emergency supplement to bring her to the of the maximum \$2<u>3</u>04 standard for a one person household in April <u>2021</u>.</u>

**Example:** Anita and her spouse applied for benefits on November 27, 2020 and interviewed on the December 16, 2020. The worker was able to verify Anita is receiving Unemployment Compensation of \$400 per week. The worker processes and approves the case with \$0 benefits in November 2020 and the minimum allotment of \$16 in December 2020. The system will automatically issue emergency supplements in overnight batch for \$374 in November 2020 and \$358 to the household in December 2020.

**Example:** Peter works and normally receives \$1<u>5</u>24 per month in food assistance. Peter forgot to complete his October March 2021 MCR. He received a termination notice that his benefits are closed as of October March 20210. Peter calls to complete his MCR on November April 16, 20210 reporting no changes. Peter asks about an extra \$80 on his EBT card. The worker explains the supplement was issued in response to the COVID-19 pandemic as we are issuing maximum monthly allotments emergency supplements. The extra \$80 was a supplement for MarchOctober 20210. The worker reinstates Peter for November April 20210 and he is still eligible for \$1<u>5</u>24 per month in food assistance. The system will automatically issue an emergency supplement in overnight batch for a minimum emergency supplement of \$80.95 for November April 20210, and are available the following day.

## **Manual BEGS**

- Staff need to review cases for a Manual BEG only when adding a new person to the assistance unit.
- A new BEG type **Emergency Supplement ES** was created to provide supplements manually for cases needing to add a person.
  - This is important to track the funds for this program.
- Letters won't generate when the BEG Emergency Supplement-ES is released.
  - We don't require a notice for these emergency supplements.

## Worker Responsibilities - WAC 388-437-0005

## Confirming automatic mass issuances:

Staff can confirm the automatic benefits by reviewing Benefit Issuance history in Aces.Online. The emergency supplements for the month will display as *FS/EBT – Supplemental Issuance (863)*.

Emergency supplements after March and/or April 2020<u>issuance date-will-s</u> vary from month to month. We require FNS approval on a month to month basis and the issuance dates may vary depending on approval and system availability.

After April 16, 2020, households finalized or reinstated will receive the emergency supplement in overnight batch. Advise the household that if they qualify for an emergency supplement, it will be available the following day.

**Note:** If the household is a SNAP/FAP mixed household, each month will display a *FS/EBT* – *Supplemental Issuance (863)* for a SNAP supplement and a FAP supplement.

#### Manual BEGs:

After April 16, 2020, staff are no longer required to process a manual BEG unless they are adding a person(s) to the AU. Follow the ACES Manual - <u>How do I add a person to an existing Assistance</u> <u>Unit (AU)?</u>

- 1. Once finalized, the recipient will be denied in the initial month and then added in the following month.
  - a. As the recipient isn't eligible in the initial month, do not issue an emergency supplement.
- 2. In the following month, confirm the supplement reason as Add a Person (AP). Release the supplement and add text to the notice.
- 3. Review the new total benefit amount for the household to determine if an emergency supplement is needed:
  - i. If the new benefit amount is the maximum allotment for the new household size, no emergency supplement is needed.
  - ii. If the new AP supplement and original monthly allotment amount does not total the new household maximum benefit amount, review if an additional emergency supplement (ES) is needed.
    - 1. Subtract the new benefit amount from the maximum household allotment.
    - 2. Create a Manual BEG in ACES mainframe for the difference using ES type. To create a manual BEG, see <u>Mainframe Processing - How do I manually</u> <u>create an overpayment or underpayment?</u>

Note: You may be prompted for either soft edit: 1598, " REASON SHOULD NOT BE USED IF AUTO WILL OR DID ISSUE THE SUPPLEMENT" 0294, "SHOULD AMOUNT BE > \$499?"

Once you verify the Manual BEG is needed and correct, press F4 to pass the soft edit.

**Example:** Robert gets the regular benefit amount of \$204 per month. In November 2020, he requested his daughter be added to his active food assistance. The worker pends the case for the daughters SSN. On December 10, 2020, the SSN is provided and the daughter is added to the food assistance. The worker denies the daughter for November, but is prompted for a supplement in December for \$70. The household is eligible for \$374 in December 2020, they aren't eligible for an additional emergency supplement.

**Example:** Jose and his partner regularly receive \$200 per month in food assistance. Jose took eustody of his grandchild with income and completed a change of circumstance in October 2020. Jose received an emergency supplement of \$174 for October 2020 for a two person household. On November 6, 2020, the worker processes the request to add the child. After completing the add a person, it results in a supplement of \$100. The worker reviews the total allotment issued to the household:

\$200 + \$174 emergency supplement + \$100 add a person = \$474 November 2020 total issuance
\$535 (3 person max) - \$474 = \$61 is what is owed for November 2020. The worker creates a Manual
ES BEG and releases the BEG. The \$61 emergency supplement will be available the next day.
